I. OLD BUSINESS

- Banquet Committee Report – Patty Hebner gave the following summary:
 - o Committee members included Wilma Jones, Patty Hebner, Sue Hiedemen, Connie Bergstedt (Ramona Stout was not a committee member but was a big help).
 - o Wrap up – Very positive comments; good speaker, great theme; lots of fun, people couldn't afford to go, marginal on the food; the pork was overcooked.
 - o Committee Wrap Up – It's hard to find a place in Manhattan to hold the banquet. Is there a way to have a banquet and not charge the members? Is there a way of encouraging the directors and members to attend the annual meeting? A budget should be set for the banquet. People who do not cancel their reservations should be billed.
 - o More info – 65 meals were paid for. 23 were given away free.
- Membership- Only half of the members have renewed their membership. Karen will invoice the ones that have not renewed.
- Directory – Only 14 of 65 members who have renewed also placed an ad in the directory. The board decided to publish the directory even if there were not enough ads sold to cover the cost. The board also decided to spend up to \$250 to run an ad in the Belgrade News and Bozeman Chronicle soliciting advertisers for the directory.

II. NEW BUSINESS

- Sponsorship – Karen mailed a general sponsorship letter out to all of the sponsors provided to her from the sponsorship committee.
- Shakespeare In the Parks – We have reserved Saturday, August 1st for Shakespeare in the Parks.
- Yellowstone Country Grant- Last year we received a grant from Yellowstone Country which paid for mailing visitor information packets and also staffing the museum/visitor center everyday during the summer. We will be applying for the grant again this year. The deadline to apply is Friday, February 27th.

- Farmers Market- Pat Figgins reported that the Farmers Market Committee has met and has set tentative dates of June 24 to September 9 for the 2009 season. They will be participating in the Senior Nutrition program. She has written a letter to Bob Kamp of Kamp Implement requesting permission to use the billboard located on his property to advertise the market.
- Potato Festival- Brad gave a synopsis relative to the requesting of permission from the Town Council to use Taylor Park for the Potato Festival.
- Light Pole Banners-Pat Figgins has located the light pole banners and the season greeting decoration.
- ABC 28 Presentation-Lindsey Lindgren gave a presentation about the advertising opportunity with ABC 28. In summary, she offered the chamber 20 spots per month between 7am and 4pm for a rate of \$400 per month of which the chamber would pay \$200 and the station would donate \$200.
- Belgrade News – George Hoffman offered a similar package of advertising with a full page ad run twice a month for a rate of \$400 per month of which the chamber would pay \$200 and the Belgrade News would donate \$200.
- Easter Egg Hunt – Jim Albrecht reported that the American Legion will be hosting the Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, April 11th, at 11:00 am in Taylor Park. They plan on hiding 4000 eggs! He also has "Buy Local" signs available for \$25 each.
